Thematic: We are going to be learning all about new beginnings as we observe the effects of Spring taking place. This will include:

- Learning about animals and their babies.
- Planting seeds and observing them as they grow.
- Exploring different food and where it comes from.
- What happens during Spring and how this is different to Winter.

Phonics: We shall begin to explore some letter sounds and lots of rhyme, and rhythm activities. We shall also continue to take part in our foundation for phonics sessions.



Mathematics: In our mathematics sessions, we will continue to work with numbers up to 5.

As our plants begin to grow, we will use our shape, space and measure skills to compare how tall our plants are growing.

We will also be counting seeds and helping our farmers to sort them into the correct packets ready to sell in our shop.

During our spring walks, we will identify different shapes we can see in the environment as well as beginning to describe a familiar route.

Literacy: We are going to be reading a range of books to support our learning including:



- When Spring Comes by Kevin Henkes
- The Boy Who Lost His Bumble by Trudi Esberger

These are all lovely stories that look at the changes Spring brings. We shall use these stories to support with our writing activities including:

- Plant labels
- Planting instructions
- Shopping lists



P.E: Children will be learning how to take part in PE safely and how to use equipment including how to move in a range of ways. We will become farmers and be working very hard on our farm doing lots of actions!
