Nursery Newsletter Summer Term

Thematic: Our topic of 'Once Upon a Time' will see children being submerged into the land of make believe and traditional tales. We will be learning about different characters and story settings. This will support our language and communication skills as we tell stories of magical adventures.

We will use a range of creative resources to support our favourite stories, and the characters and settings within them, to bring our stories to life!



Understanding the World:

We are going to be observing the changes that happen over Spring and Summer within the natural world. We will look at what is growing, the animals and creatures we see and how the weather changes. We will also consider the changes in materials through activities such as cooking.

Personal, Social and Emotional

<u>development</u>: Through our 'Relationships' topic, we will discuss different families and how to form and maintain positive relationships. Our 'Changing Me' topic, will help us to prepare for our transition into Reception.

<u>P.E:</u> Nursery AM/ PM - Wednesday Please remove all jewellery and come to Nursery in suitable PE clothing. **Phonics:** We will identify words which start with certain sounds through games and activities. Children will complete a range of rhyme and rhythm activities daily and will observe and explore letters and sounds during continuous provision.



<u>Mathematics</u>: In our mathematics sessions, we will continue to work with numbers up to 5. The children will start to recognise these numbers and accurately count out objects to match. You can practise this at home too!

We will be exploring capacity and weight in our outdoor area.

To help some of our story characters find their way back home, we will also be planning and drawing simple routes.

<u>Summer: Once Upon a Time</u> Who's been eating my porridge?

Literacy: We are going to be reading a

range of stories this term including:

- Goldilocks and the Three Bears
- Jack and the Beanstalk
- The Three Billy Goats Gruff

These are traditional tales that the children will become familiar with and learn to re-tell. We will use these stories to support with our learning across the curriculum, especially our literacy activities.

These will include:

- Re-telling stories using props and puppets
- Ordering main events in stories
- Mark-making in and with different materials
